PREPARE ENTRIES: Entry forms will be completed on-line. Feel free to enter more than one project/item per category; however, **you may only enter one of each sub-category** (for example, you cannot enter two [2] black & white photos). The category you select will be reviewed and confirmed by the committee at check-in. To avoid a possible exclusion of an item because of a duplication in a category at check-in, it is highly suggested to reach out to Helene and Dawn should you have any questions.

Age (determined by age the first day of Grand session) divisions are:

- Jobie-2-Bee (8-10 yrs old)
- Junior (13-16 yrs old)
- Beginner (10-12 yrs old)
- Senior (17-19 yrs old)

Please make sure that you designate one adult as the contact person for all entries coming from your Bethel.

2025 Centerpiece Competition Rules

1. Only one entry per Bethel.
2. Bethel members must make the centerpiece. Members need not attend Grand Bethel to participate.
3. Centerpiece must follow or relate to the theme of its category and incorporate Job’s Daughters.
4. Cost must not exceed \$25.00.
5. The maximum dimensions are:
 - a. Must fit in an 18” by 18” square, oval, or round area.
 - b. Maximum height of 10”.
 - c. Your design should be balanced and able to stand on its own and not block the view of people seated at the table.
6. Entry must be appealing and viewed from all sides.
7. Candles may be used, but not lit.
8. Electricity will **not** be provided.
9. The entry must appear anonymous. Bethel number, location, and Daughters’ names must not appear anywhere on the centerpiece.
10. Please include a statement (limit to one page) explaining whatever you would like people to know about your centerpiece. It could explain any symbolism, construction, materials used, etc.
 - a. It does not need to be attached and does not affect the dimension requirements.
 - b. This will be read by the judges and also be made available for everyone.

Theme Options:

1. How will you help grow the garden of Job's Daughters?
2. How have you grown in Ethel's Garden/ Job's Daughters?
3. What do you see for the future of Ethel's Garden/ Job's Daughters?

Maximum Length: No more than three typewritten pages, double-spaced in Times New Roman or Arial fonts, in 11 to 12 point font.

Category: Poetry

Theme Options:

1. Growing Ethel's Garden
2. Garden gnomes and/ or flowers
3. Acts of Kindness
4. Leadership

Maximum Length: No more than three typewritten pages, double-spaced in Times New Roman or Arial fonts, in 11 to 12 point font.

Category: Creative Writing

Theme: Create a fictional story using one or more of the Grand themes of "Growing Ethel's Garden", growth of self, garden gnomes, flowers, leadership, and/ or acts of kindness.

Maximum Length: No more than 20 typewritten pages, double-spaced in Times New Roman or Arial fonts, in 11 to 12 point font.

Category: Librarian's Report

Theme: Curate a collection of five to ten pieces of literature, arts or the sciences, which may be used for a Librarian's Report during a Bethel meeting. Provide a three to five sentence analysis or explanation of why each piece was selected and the benefit of the selection for Bethel members.

Maximum Length: Individual selections in the collection should be able to be presented orally during a Bethel meeting in under 10 minutes. Selections may be summarized or referenced by title and author, depending on their original form/ publication.

“Growing Ethel’s Garden” 2025 Music & Signing Competitions

General Information for Performing Arts Competitions – Please read ALL guidelines and rules.

1. A practice room will be available with a piano and speaker for warm-up prior to competition. Each individual or group entrant will be given 15 minutes prior to their performance for time in the practice room.
2. No spectators will be allowed in any competition rooms.
3. Specific attire guidelines for each performing arts competition are described in their respective forms below.
4. Ensembles can be Daughters from one Bethel, or from multiple Bethels. This allows Daughters the option to work with sisters from across the jurisdiction, strengthening the bonds formed during other state events. It also allows smaller Bethels the opportunity to compete more equitably with larger Bethels.
5. If you are a Grand Bethel Officer, Grand Bethel Representative, Miss Nebraska Job’s Daughter Candidate or Spirit Ambassador Candidate, please check the guidelines given to you by those in charge of your practices and activities to make sure you are eligible to enter the music competition. If you are, please note any conflicts with scheduling on the Registration Form.
6. Attached are the forms for entry in each competition. Please fill out each form completely, noting any known conflicts on each form.

MUSIC COMPETITIONS

General Guidelines for Vocal Competitions

- Selections are to be memorized.
- The accompanist may be either an Adult or a Daughter. If a Bethel needs an accompanist, please indicate this on the registration form. We can help you coordinate with one.
- A piano and speaker will be provided unless you prefer to use your own.
- All vocal competitions will be judged on Tempo, Dynamics, Technique, Blending, Tonal Quality, Interpretation, Rhythm, and Stage Presence. Degree of Difficulty and Appropriateness will also be judged for vocal small ensemble and individual voice.

Bethel Choir Competition

- Five (5) or more girls are considered a choir, there is NO limit to the number of girls that may compete.
- Apparel for Bethel Choir competition is official Job's Daughter regalia.
- The following songs have been chosen for the competition:
“Welcome Song” & “We’re Job’s Daughters Fair and True” from the JDI Music Ritual

Novelty Choir Competition

- Five (5) or more girls are considered a choir, there is NO limit to the number of girls that may compete.
- Apparel for Novelty Choir competition will be attire appropriate to the musical selection.
- Costumes and props are encouraged and welcome!
- Each novelty choir sings one (1) song of their choosing. The selection must be appropriate. If you have any questions regarding your selection, we would be happy to review it ahead of time.
- Maximum time allowed per novelty choir is six (6) minutes.
- Each novelty choir will be responsible for accompaniment. Accompaniment may not include any background voice(s).
- Don't forget your sheet music! Each novelty choir must have 2 copies of the music with the measures numbered to be handed to the judges at the time of competition.

Vocal Small Ensemble Competition

- This competition is designed for a small group that numbers a minimum of two (2) to a maximum of four (4) Daughters.
- There are no age divisions. All groups compete against each other.
- Each small ensemble sings one (1) song of their choosing. The selection must be appropriate. If you have any questions regarding your selection, we would be happy to review it ahead of time.
- Groups are encouraged to sing a song that has some harmony included, at least for a portion of the song.
- Maximum time allowed per small group is six (6) minutes.
- Each small ensemble will be responsible for their own accompaniment. Accompaniment may not include any background voice(s).
- Don't forget your sheet music! Each small group must have 2 copies of the music with the measures numbered to be handed to the judges at the time of competition.
- Apparel for all group competitions should be official Job's Daughter regalia **OR** business casual attire (dress, skirt and blouse, jumpsuit, etc.)

Individual Voice Competition

There will be four divisions for vocal competition as follows:

- Division JTB: Ages 8-9 years old as of 6/25/2025
- Division I: Ages 10 – 13 years as of 6/25/2025
- Division II: Ages 14 – 16 years as of 6/25/2025
- Division III: Ages 17 – 20 years as of 6/25/2025

GUIDELINES:

- ONE vocal solo allowed PER MEMBER.
- Maximum time limit for a vocal solo is five (5) minutes.
- The selection must be appropriate. If you have questions about your selection, we would be happy to review it ahead of time. If the competitor has participated at a previous Grand Session in individual voice, the musical selection must be different from the previous year.
- You must bring 2 copies of sheet music with the measures numbered to the competition.
- Each Daughter will be responsible for accompaniment. Accompaniment on a personal device (i.e., phone, Bluetooth speaker) may be used, but it must not include any background voice(s). A great place to look for accompaniment tracks is on YouTube, search for an instrumental or karaoke version of your song. A piano and speaker will be provided unless the Daughter prefers to use her own device.
- Apparel for individual competitions should be official Job's Daughter regalia **OR** business casual attire (dress, skirt and blouse, jumpsuit, etc.).

Instrumental Small Ensemble Competition

- This competition is designed for a small group that numbers a minimum of two (2) to a maximum of four (4) Daughters.
- There are no age divisions. All groups compete against each other.
- Each small ensemble performs one (1) song of their choosing. The selection must be appropriate. If you have any questions regarding your selection, we would be happy to review it ahead of time.
- Please bring your own instrument. Piano is the only instrument that will be provided.
- Maximum time allowed per selection is ten (10) minutes.
- Don't forget your sheet music! Each small group must have 2 copies of the music with the measures numbered to be handed to the judges at the time of competition.
- Apparel for all group competitions should be official Job's Daughter regalia **OR** business casual attire (dress, skirt and blouse, jumpsuit, etc.)

Individual Instrumental Competition (includes Piano)

There will be three divisions as follows:

- Beginner: Playing for 3 years or less
- Intermediate: Playing for 4-6 years
- Advanced: Playing for 7 or more years

GUIDELINES:

- Maximum time allowed per selection is ten (10) minutes.
- Daughter chooses an individual performance piece of her choice. Please advise what instrument you will be playing so that we may provide proper judges.
- Please bring your own instrument. Piano is the only instrument that will be provided.
- The selection **DOES NOT** have to be memorized.
- You must have 2 copies of your selection with the measures numbered to be handed to the judges at the time of competition.
- The Daughter **IS ALLOWED TO HAVE ACCOMPANIMENT**, either by piano or personal device. If using other accompaniment, the track must be only instrumental, meaning no background voice(s) or background singing. A speaker and/or piano will be available for use. Daughter must provide her own accompanist.
- Apparel should be official Job's Daughter regalia **OR** business casual attire (dress, skirt and blouse, jumpsuit, etc.)
- Each individual will be judged on Tone, Interpretation, Tempo, Proficiency, Dynamics, Technique, Stage Presence and Degree of Difficulty.

SIGNING COMPETITIONS

General Guidelines for Signing Competitions

- There will be three divisions for this competition:
 - Large Ensemble: 5+ members
 - Small Ensemble: 2-4 members. This division allows for members to compete in a smaller group aside from the group of members representing their Bethel in the small or large Bethel division, especially if they wish to perform a different song option from their Bethel.
 - Individual Solo
 - Division I: Ages 10 – 13 years as of 6/25/2025
 - Division II: Ages 14 – 16 years as of 6/25/2025
 - Division III: Ages 17 – 20 years as of 6/25/2025
- Daughter(s) will enter the competition room and stand where the judges can see all movements clearly.
- Each Daughter/Ensemble will be judged on the following criteria:
 - Overall impression/"Stage" presence
 - Accuracy of signs as demonstrated on video.
 - Expression (facial expressions, eyes/head following signs)
 - Signs should be large enough to be seen across a room
 - Groups will be judged on the uniformity of signs and synchronization of movements.
- Apparel for all signing competitions will be business casual. A dress, skirt and blouse, jumpsuit, suit, etc. are all acceptable options.
- There will be awards for each division.
- Jobie-to-Bees are allowed to participate in any division.

All competitors MUST choose option 1 or 2, NOT both.

OPTION 1: "How Great Thou Art" (Verse 1)

- Accompaniment track/speaker, including the words, will be provided for the performance and in the practice rooms.
- An instruction video for "How Great Thou Art" can be found here:

OPTION 2: Song of your choice. If you have any questions regarding your selection, we would be happy to review it ahead of time.

- Maximum time limit of 6 minutes.
- Audio for the song must be provided for the performance.
- Daughter must provide a copy of the lyrics of her song of choice for the judges. This allows the judges to mark the accuracy of the performance.
